Support for solar projects in rural India



PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana

- Up to 60% subsidy for rooftop solar (≤ 2 kW)
- 40% subsidy for 2-3 kW
- Income from surplus energy

Grid-Connected Rooftop Solar Program:

- 40% subsidy for systems up to 3 kW
- 20% subsidy for 3-10 kW
- Aims for 40,000 MW by 2026

PM-KUSUM Scheme:

- 50% subsidies for solar pumps and decentralized power plants

Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for Solar Manufacturing:

- Build domestic solar manufacturing
- Incentivize high-efficiency solar PV modules

Delhi Solar Policy 2024:

- Reduced electricity bills with rooftop solar
- "Zero-cost" bills for residential consumers
- Generation-based incentives
- Community solar options
