



## HEAL Conference Travel Awards

HEAL Conference Travel Awards are available on a competitive basis to HEAL Network Members to subsidise attendances at national or international conferences in order to present a HEAL research paper or poster.

### Purpose

The grants are intended to support HEAL Network members who are early-mid career researchers or HEAL Network members who can demonstrate they are undertaking applied policy and practice translation and/or research. This scheme provides opportunities for awardees to present research and/or projects aligned to HEAL Research Themes to national or international audiences

- Foster and develop collaborations with national and international colleagues

The grant must be used to cover such expenses as:

- Return economy airfares between Australia (applicant's Institution) and the conference location
- Conference registration
- Costs towards accommodation

### Eligibility:

HEAL Travel Awards will be available to applicants who:

- Have had an abstract accepted for presentation at a conference of national or international significance
- The abstract must be aligned to a HEAL-Themes and contribute to a peer-reviewed journal publication, dataset or communication tool (acknowledging the HEAL NHMRC grant) and or policy brief
- Have the support of a HEAL Investigator or able to seek support from a member of the HEAL Leadership Executive
- An applicant is limited to one successful application per year

### Value and Funding

Total funding available each year is \$50 000 . The maximum amount the eligible candidates may apply for is \$2000.

### How to apply

Applicants must submit an application with supporting documentation to HEAL National Research Network Manager Laura Pareezer by emailing [Laura.Pareezer@anu.edu.au](mailto:Laura.Pareezer@anu.edu.au)

These grants are open February-November each year or until the annual funding allocation is exhausted.

The following supporting documentation must accompany the application

- Presenter (Name, Job Title, Affiliation, ECR status, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander status)
- HEAL Investigator sponsoring the travel grant request (if different from applicant)
- Name of Conference, Location and dates
- Copy of applicant's notification that their abstract has been accepted to the conference.
- Abstract of the paper being presented
- Journal or platform and timeline of publication (e.g. full manuscript, dataset, policy brief, video, artwork)
- Statement of alignment to HEAL's vision and theme(s) (100 words)
- Statement of benefits to the researcher(s) and broader community (100 words)
- Amount being sought
- Itemised budget
