Research problem

! 'Access to essential energy' not well defined and subject to interpretations

→ policies risk (re)producing energy poverty

Capability Approach

- Evaluates freedoms & achievements of valued doings or beings (Sen 1979)
- Functionings express 'what matters' (Nussbaumer et al. 2011)



EU project evaluating health benefits of energy poverty interventions

Methods

6 Focus groups with WELLBASED 7 home visits in 4 professionals (31 participants)

Urban tours, incl. WELLBASED cities

Findings

Set of functionings that are relative to the human physical, emotional and social nature across contexts



Communicating

Keeping cool

Preserving food



Washing with hot water

Monitoring energy use

affordable through

o efficiency (H, L)

supplier (J)

(J,E)

free choice in heating

flexibility in fuel sources

Rich descriptions of each functioning

- → warmth, health, survival
- **fixed** heating system (all)
- able to heat all rooms (all),
- individually controllable (J, H, L,O)
- with quick response times (L)
- fire **safe** (V)
- billed
 - according to household consumption (J, O)
 - in close proximity to real time (H, V)

Discussion

- Complementary perceptions - differentiation evident in priorities
- **Convergence** of perceptions across the six locations
- → supports the principle of "universality" of functionings
- 'Rich description
- → Better recognition of 'what matters

Recommendations

→ **support advocacy** initiatives, e.g. 'right to energy"
